

Building Adaptive Expertise for Teaching Health Education

OUTLINE OF THE COURSE:

- * What makes health education knowledge, 'health education knowledge' in the NZC, and how deep is my knowledge of the underlying concepts and big ideas?
- * How do I know if my students' health education knowledge learning is 'progressing', and how skilled am I in my ability to inquire into this and respond to what I find out?
- * What do I need to think about when planning a teaching and learning programme based on new and emerging health or wellbeing issues?
- * What do I need to consider when including aspects of mātauranga Māori and other cultural knowledge alongside academic health education knowledge?
- * As education policies and systems change, what do I need to know about health education that will enable me to problem solve in new situations? What subject and wider curriculum knowledge will allow me to respond flexibly, efficiently and effectively to our complex educational environment where there are multiple factors to consider?

If you are a primary or secondary school teacher and these questions interest you, this 2-day TRCC workshop is for you. Using the most recent NZ strategy statements, policy, resources and research available, participants will engage in a succession of discussions with teaching colleagues and other experts to respond to questions like these.
